1. Leaders overwhelmingly perceive that the volume and complexities of risks they face are increasing extensively; however most do not describe their risk management process as mature or robust.




2. Most organisations struggle to integrate their risk management and strategic decision making activities, leading to a perception that risk management does not provide competitive advantage.


